Narrative citations: Jackson (2019) and Sapolsky (2017) Provide the author, year of publication, title, and publisher of the book. Include any edition information in parentheses after the title, without italics. If the book includes a DOI, include the DOI in the reference after the publisher name.

Book References - APA Style

If you want to cite a book chapter in APA format, you need to include the chapter author's name either in the introductory phrase before the quote or in the parenthetical citation after it, along with the publication date and page number.

How to Cite a Book Chapter in APA: 10 Steps (with Pictures)

Basic book citation format The APA in-text citation for a book includes the author's last name, the year, and (if relevant) a page number. In the reference list, start with the author's last name and initials, followed by the year. The book title is written in sentence case (only capitalize the first word and any proper nouns).

How to Cite a Book in APA Style | Formats & Examples

The edition is added by adding the number and the abbreviation for edition, which is "ed." Add a period and comma after ed. Then, add the page numbers of the chapter, which are preceded by the abbreviation for pages, which is "pp." Place in parentheses, and add a period after the parentheses.

Essentially, you should cite the largest entity that the author in question is responsible for. In fact APA book chapter citation does not differ much from basic book citation format. If the author wrote the entire book, then provide a reference for the whole book.

Book Chapter References On the other hand, if the chapter comes from a book where each chapter is written by different authors (and the whole thing is put together by an editor), then provide a separate reference for each chapter that you used.

The 7th edition of APA does not differentiate between the format of the books, print or electronic. Cite both the same way. If you have an open-access eBook, you may provide the URL at the end, provided it directly takes you to the full text without logging in.

If there are different authors for each chapter, you need to reference EACH chapter you use. If you use multiple chapters from a book with different authors for each chapter, you still need to reference EACH chapter you use. (This is because you need to acknowledge who wrote the work you are using, not the person who edited/compiled the book).
